- 3 *That the relevant provisions of the Life-saving Equipment Regulations, 1968, the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, IMO Resolution MSC.81(70) Part 1, as amended and the Merchant Shipping (National Small Vessel Safety) Regulations, 2007, are complied with at all times.*
- 4 *The equipment remains satisfactory in service.*

This certificate remains valid until the date stated hereon, unless canceled or revoked by the Authority, which may withdraw this approval at any time for reasons of non-compliance with the applicable regulations referred to in this Certificate of Approval
