



<p>This approval is issued for the items specified herein and in terms of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Regulation 47(2) read with Annex 10 of the Life-Saving Equipment Regulation, 1968;</li> <li>- Regulation 4, Chapter III, Part A, of the International Convention on safety of Life at Sea, 1974 as amended.</li> </ul> <p>The item(s) concerned are hereby approved for use on board South African ships which are required to comply with the above regulations.</p> <p>This approval is issued for the items described as follows -</p> <p><i>The lights are manufactured by Daniamant Ltd and consist of white position indicating lights and are fitted to lifejackets. The lights are battery powered and are of the water activated flashing type. These lights have been manufactured in accordance with SOLAS standards and tested in accordance with the recommendation on Testing of Life-Saving Appliances, IMO Res. MSC 81(70) Part 1.</i></p>					
<p>The approval is subject to the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 The equipment manufactured has not been modified or varied from the original, tested prototype or specimen;</li> <li>2 The equipment displays the date of manufacture and the date of expiry of the light unit;</li> <li>3 Clear and concise instructions of use are indelibly printed onto the product label and;</li> <li>4 The equipment remains fit for use whilst in service.</li> </ol> <p>This certificate remains valid until the date stated hereon, unless canceled or revoked by the Authority, which may withdraw this approval at any time for reasons of non-compliance with the applicable regulations referred to in this Certificate of Approval.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the manufacturer to notify the Authority of any modifications or changes to the equipment to ensure the continued validity of this certificate.</p>
