**This approval is issued for the items described as:**

Lifejacket water activated flashing light, type; **Daniamant L6A**. This light is operated automatically when in the water. They comply with regulation 2.2.3.2 of the LSA Code. The light is supplied with mounting clip for fixing to the lifejackets.

**The approval is subject to the following conditions:**

1. That the equipment manufactured has not been modified or varied from the original tested prototype or specimen;
2. Each light shall be marked in accordance with the Life Saving Appliance Code Regulation 1.2.2.9, in which case the name of the testing authority is acceptable.
3. Each user shall be provided with operations manual and detailed fitting and maintenance instructions
4. That the equipment remains satisfactory in service.

This certificate remains valid until the date stated hereon, unless cancelled or revoked by the Authority, which may withdraw this approval at any time for reasons of non-compliance with the applicable regulations referred to in this Certificate of Approval

It is the responsibility of the manufacturer to notify the Authority of any modifications or changes to the equipment to ensure the continued validity of this certificate.
