CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

1. Replacement of the batteries is not allowed and their removal should not be possible without destroying the container. The light unit must be replaced on or before the expiry date marked on its label.
2. Detailed fitting, maintenance and in service test instructions are to be provided to each purchaser of the subject lights.
3. Each light is to be marked with the information required by the LSA Code Regulation 1.2.2.9.
4. The lifejacket type where the subject design of light is fitted should be tested in accordance with IMO Resolution MSC.81(70), I/10.3.3 to confirm the adequacy of their means of attachment.
5. If the specified standards are amended during the validity of this certificate, this product type is to be re-approved prior to it being supplied to vessels to which the amended standards apply.
6. The arrangements and installation of the lights on board are not part of this design appraisal or certificate and are to be to the satisfaction of the Surveyors attending on board.
